

How to Apply for a WBIF Grant?

The WBIF provides funding for projects and programmes across various sectors, including energy, the environment, transport, digital infrastructure, human capital, and the private sector.

Funding opportunities are available through annual or biannual calls for proposals.

To be eligible for funding, project applications must comply with the eligibility criteria and requirements outlined in the Guidelines for Applicants for Blending Operations published for each call for proposals.
